*For high dry matter silage, square bales, Haylage, heavy or wet bales and a longer storage life we recommend a minimum six layers of film.*

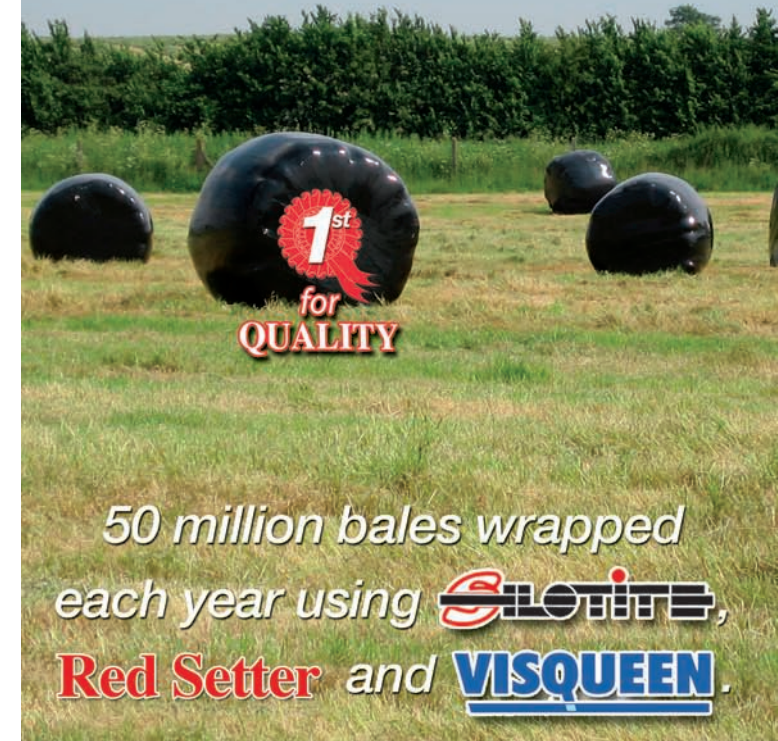

### Strength
